Description of methodology (methods, tools & material used, etc)

ISDP's Malaria program is to ensure by 2023, children under 5, male and female adults living in malarial areas have access to appropriate malaria prevention, diagnosis and treatment services decrease the number of Malaria affected people to 1 in 1000.

To ensure these objectives are accomplished ISDP is obliged to implement Malaria BCC activities cooperating with the ministry of health executing Community dialogue, Malaria Field-day, Door-to-door Malaria BCC lessons and Support & supervisions.

ISDP Malaria Project field coordinator and ISDP health supervisor carry out the implementing partner supervision activity at Burtinle, Harfo, Bacadweyn and Galkaio districts and the field visit will take 5 days from 26-30 Nov 2023.

During supervision.

The implemented partner supervision was held from 26 to 30 November 2023, which was carried out by Farhia Abdiwahab Mohamed the senior program Officer and Farah Ahmed Mohamed Nutrition Officer. Among the places visited was Burtinle in Nugal region, which is one of the districts in the malaria elimination phase in Puntland, and among the places visited: Harfo, Badaadweyn and Galkayo in Mudug region.

Aim of Supervision:

The purpose of the Supervision was to observe the malaria awareness Activities going on in the areas we visited, we met with malaria awareness workers and health officials in the areas we Overseen.

What we talked about is the situation of the rains that have fallen or are expected, which can cause mosquitoes to breed in the stagnant water left by the rains, which can cause the outbreak of malaria in those areas. We also talked about how to educate the Community about the Diagnosis, treatment, prevention and control of malaria.

Supervision Findings.

- In most of the cities we visited we saw a lot of stagnant water in many places.
- people were afraid of the expected rain storm which started some places.
- Malaria outreach workers were on their duties.
- Community Elders we meet during supervision demanding livelihood intervention at IDPs as do other organizations.
- Lack of motivation for community Educators.
- The RDTs and ACTs were available at all supervised Health facilities

Constraints

Lack of Motivation among Malaria Community Educators.
Low knowledge for mosquito larva source and how they manage in community level specially internal displaced people.

Recommendations

- community awareness on malaria Diagnosis, Treatment, prevention and control should be accelerating.
- Educating community for larva source and how they can manage.
